BEST RED WINES UP TO \$ 40



Tasting good wine has been part of people's lives since ancient times, and Jesus Christ and the apostles sat at the table to always celebrate with the presence of good wine.

Tasting wine has always been synonymous with relaxation, a good time and something pleasurable. So, let's treat the best red wines up to \$40 and how to harmonize and match good dishes.

In addition, the Wine Searcher (https://www.wine-searcher.com/), which is the largest wine database on the Internet to gather the best value for money and offer a list of various wines, was presented a list choices from slightly more expensive and good red wines to cheaper and good red wines, as well as gift red wine options for that special evening or occasion.

1. Gran Coronas Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 - Spain



Miguel Torres family winery is one of the most renowned in Spain and is always in the spotlight. Penedès red wine has a large structure and is juicy and inviting. The wine is a red composed of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Tempranillo, aged for 15 months in French and American oak barrels.

The red wine has a closed ruby red color of violet highlights and aromas of more mature red and black fruits, as well as floral, menthol and eucalyptus notes, as well as mineral, toasted, smoked and tobacco touches.

Red wine on the palate is fruity, round, structured, has good acidity, fine tannins and rich texture, good mouth volume and a persistent and juicy finish that invites one more sip.

Red wine harmonizes with beef, lamb and poultry.

2. Herdade São Miguel Touriga Franca 2010 - Portugal



Alentejo red wine of exceptional value for money. Red wine has structure and quality of fruit, in a more austere and elegant style. A juicy, round red wine with great acidity. Red wine harmonizes with game meat and pasta with sauces and has an alcohol content of 13.5%.

Red wine stays in French oak barrels for 8 months. Red wine has a ripe red fruit aroma and white flowers well integrated with balsamic and coconut notes and the palate is round, rich and voluminous with balanced acidity and fine tannins and has a long and complex finish.

3. Icardi Barbera D'Asti Tabaren 2011 – Italy



A pleasant, light red wine from Piedmont and Barbera d'Asti is a great suggestion for new drinkers as it has light tannins and fruity notes.

An ideal red wine to accompany antipasti and pasta with red sauces. The name of the red wine Tabaren in dialect means cabaret, because the wine is festive, balanced and fresh and combines with the old French theaters.

The red wine harmonizes with roasted and grilled white meats with medium intensity sauces, pasta with red sauces and antipasti.

4. Norton Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 - Argentina



Red wine has frank fruit aromas such as blackberry and a smoky tantalizing. Cabernet Sauvignon's docile, ripe and juicy tannins are the highlight.

Red wine is a faithful companion for roasted meats. The red wine has ruby red color, ripe red fruit aroma, mint and chocolate notes.

Red wine in the mouth is concentrated, intense, with round and ripe tannins and good finish. Red wine is made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes and has an alcohol content of 14.4%.

5. Perez Cruz Limited Edition 2010 - Chile



Viña Pérez Cruz is located in Alto Maipo and under the responsibility of the talented winemaker Germán Lyon produces red wine made from 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Petit Verdot and 2% Syrah and aged 14 months in French oak barrels.

The red wine has an intense ruby red color with purple highlights and aromas of cherries, cassis and plums, as well as floral, herbaceous and pepper notes, as well as toasty and chocolate aromas.

Red wine on the palate is fruity, potent, full, balanced, juicy, has good acidity, ripe tannins and persistent finish. Red wine harmonizes with roasted or stewed red meats accompanied by spice and mushroom sauces, which are suggestions for escorting red wine.

6. Rigal the Original Malbec 2012 - France



When you talk about Malbec you usually think of Argentina, but you can't forget that the grape variety comes from France.

In France especially in Cahors the grape produces great specimens such as the Rigal the Original Malbec 2012 a cost-effective French red wine. Red wine is made from Malbec grapes planted in a small sub-region of Southwest France, where the Rigal originated. The original Malbec red wine is fresh and balanced and stands out for black fruit notes such as blackberries, black plums and currants, spices and vanilla aromas.

wine is a refreshing and pleasant medium-bodied Malbec, ideal to accompany light red meat preparations. Red wine blends well with roasted red meats, game meats, poultry preparations with medium-intensity sauces, sausages and medium cheeses and the alcohol content is 12%.

7. Santa Carolina Cabernet Sauvignon Family Reserve 2009 – Chile



Red wine is one of Chile's classic Cabernet Sauvignon. The high acidity and full-bodied structure balance beautifully with the pronounced and very soft tannins.

The red wine is medium violet in color with the aroma of ripe dark fruits such as cherries and dark chocolate. Red wine in the mouth is dry, full bodied, has good acidity, velvety tannins and a balanced finish.

Red wine ages 15 months in barrel and 6 months in the bottle before marketing and is ideal for accompanying pasta, red meat and aged cheese, and has an alcohol content of 13.8%.

8. Surazo Private Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2002 - Chile



An 11-year-old red wine that greatly enriched a ruby-colored Cabernet Sauvignon wine, poorly translucent and sophisticated aromas of evolution, tending towards balsamic and black fruits in jam.

The red wine aged 12 months in French oak barrels and retains its liveliness and elegance, with well-integrated wood flavors and fine tannins.

The red wine leaves a delicious taste of dark chocolate coffee at the end of the mouth and is powerful and robust, has a very good structure, tasty, present and ripe tannins and a very pleasant finish.

The red wine harmonizes with roast lamb with fruit jelly which is a suggestion to perfectly harmonize, as well as beef and poultry. Red wine has an alcohol content of 14%.

9. Tellus Syrah 2011 - Italy



Red wine is an excellent Italian Syrah produced by Falesco, a company of the brothers Renzo and Ricardo Cotarella in the Lazio region, and is a great company for grilled red meat.

Tellus is the Roman goddess of the earth and her bottle inspired by the ancient bottles of the Roman Empire is different and catches the eye and the label was created in 2009 and is the fourth winner of a contest with artists at the Castel Sant'Angelo in Rome for the creation of the new product image.

Syrah red wine surprises all expectations as it is elegant, with a striking personality and persistent finish.

Red wine has an alcohol content of 14% and matures for 5 months in second-use oak barrels.

10. Trivento Reserve Malbec 2011 - Argentina



A 100% Malbec red wine that impresses with its elegance and tannic texture. Red wine on the nose has complex aromas with notes of tea, tobacco and graphite, as well as floral and licorice aromas.

Trivento red wine ages 12 months in oak barrels and has a bright ruby color, plum, vanilla and oak aroma.

Red wine has a very excellent cost-benefit and harmonizes perfectly with game meats and pasta with tomato sauces and its alcohol content is 13%.

11. Escorihuela Gascon Malbec 2017 - Argentina



The red wine Malbec after aging in oak gained even more ripe fruit in its aromas, which combined with notes of violets and sweet spices.

The red wine in the mouth has all its personality from Mendonça, with soft, ripe and elegant tannins, without fear of showing its wooden marks and has an intense aroma of red fruits, dried fruits and eucalyptus notes and the tannins are soft and round. , has a balanced finish, long and very pleasant.

The red wine is aged 8 months in French and American oak barrels and its alcohol content is 14% and red egg harmonizes with barbecue of noble meat and grape leaf stuffed with lamb.

12. Baladero Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 - Argentina

An excellent Cabernet Sauvignon with good value for money. The red wine has an intense ruby color with clear and bright violet tones.



Red wine highlights aromas of fruity cherries and ripe blackberries and currants and also aromas of spices such as cloves and black pepper, with slight aromas of mint, tobacco and leather.

The red wine is full-bodied and balanced, with great acidity and soft present tannins and has the intense retro taste of jam fruits, with subtle vanilla touch.

The red wine harmonizes with red meat, mushroom pasta and hard cheese.

13. Alto Landon Red 2008 - Spain



The winery is located in Landete in the province of Cuenca and produces this red from Syrah, Grenache, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes, aged 12 months in French barrels.

The red wine has a ruby red color of violet highlights and aromas of more ripe black fruits, floral notes, smoked and toasted, as well as aromas of licorice and tobacco.

The red wine in the mouth is fruity, juicy, has soft tannins and a long and pleasant finish and surprises by the elegance and balance of the set.

Pair with grilled counter steak, escorted by roasted potatoes and mushrooms, and red wine also harmonizes with other beef, pasta, veal and poultry.

14. Cordillera Carignan 2008 - Chile



Red wine made from Carignan, Merlot and Syrah grapes from vines over 80 years old, with aging in 30% new oak barrels and 70% of second use.

The red wine has a ruby red color with purple highlights and captivating aromas of ripe red fruits, reminding blackberries, strawberries and raspberries, as well as floral, mineral, herbaceous and sweet spice aromas.

Red wine in the mouth is fruity, balanced, deep, fresh, elegant, has good acidity, soft tannins and silky and persistent finish.

A versatile red wine that can accompany sausages and drenched red meats.

15. W Explorer Series Quinta do Crasto D.O.C. Douro 2014 - Portugal



Red wine with aromas of ripe black fruits, cocoa and spices and red wine brings soft tannins, pleasant acidity, good body and toasty finish.

A red wine made in the Douro, one of the noblest appellations of origin in Portugal and the label brings the region's typicality to integrate the incredible and exclusive W Explorer Series project.

Red wine is an example produced from grapes grown in the Douro Superior in a premium terroir and on the left bank of the Douro River.

The red wine harmonizes with steak à marrare which is one of the simplest and most sophisticated dishes in the world, filet mignon risotto with parmesan, duck ragout tagliatelle, portuguese feijoada, hunter chicken, roast alheiras which is a typical cold cut from Portugal and harmonizes with caramelized onions and the alcohol content is 14.50%

16. Trivento Reserve Malbec 2011 - Argentina



Red wine made exclusively from Malbec grapes and aged for six months in French oak barrels.

The red wine has a ruby red color of violet highlights and aromas of ripe black fruits, aromas of tea, tobacco and graphite, as well as floral and licorice aromas.

The red wine in the mouth is fruity, has fine tannins, great acidity and long finish and impresses with its elegance and tannic texture.

Trivento red wine ages 12 months in oak barrels and harmonizes well with game meats and pasta with tomato sauces.

17. Vilosell 2009 - Spain



Red wine composed of Tempranillo, Syrah, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cariñena grapes and aged for nine months in French oak barrels.

The red wine has a ruby red color of violet reflections and aromas of ripe black fruits reminding cassis and blackberries, floral notes, spices and smoked, as well as aromas of tobacco and chocolate.

Red wine in the mouth confirms the fruit style, is structured, very balanced, has soft tannins, good acidity and persistent and juicy finish.

Red wine harmonizes with beef, pasta, veal and poultry.

18. Robertson Winery Pinotage 2018 - South Africa



John Platter, the most respected South African critic, regards the tasty red wine as one of the best values for money Pinotage in the country.

John Platter describes red wine as marvelous, with striking aromas of ripe fruit and an elegant, well-behaved style and deserving 4 stars from the critic.

The red wine has an alcohol content of 13%, fermentation in stainless steel tanks, with temperature control between 23 and 26°C for 4 days.

The red wine blends perfectly with pasta, pizza such as margherita, lamb, beef, roast poultry and stews.

19. RAR Masi Wine Project Malbec Merlot - Argentina



The project to plant Malbec and Merlot in Tupungato is very interesting in this wine. Red wine has an olfactory complexity surprising as it brings floral notes, combined with nuances of flesh and even a curious citrus touch.

Red wine in the mouth has the same olfactory complexity, yet aromas of sandalwood all in great balance and elegance.

The red wine has an alcoholic strength of 14%. It has a deep ruby red color with violet dyed highlights and has ripe plums, blackberry jam and cocoa on the nose.

The red wine is firm and well balanced in the palate, with soft tannins and supporting acidity and the long finish with the fruit and spices first checked on smell and then on the palate.

The red wine is versatile and harmonizes with grilled or roasted red meat or cheese with intense flavor.

20. Tarapacá Cosecha Merlot 2017 – Chile



Chilean red wine will win hearts because, besides being cheap, it was thought to accompany one of the best things in life: pasta with tomato sauce and Merlot is the type of grape that gives a delicate flavor to red wine.

The red wine harmonizes with meats such as filet mignon, duck ragout, pasta, sauces and Bolognese lasagna, risottos, Shimeji mushrooms, chestnuts and pesto. It also harmonizes with gouda, brie and gruyère cheeses and has an alcohol content of 13%.

21. Concha y Toro Reserved Malbec - Argentina



A medium-dry red wine made from the Malbec grape and rests on an American oak barrel. The red wine has ruby color with violet tones and aroma of violets, black fruits such as blackberries, plums and prunes.

The red wine with palate is light with soft tannins and balanced acidity and harmonizes with recipe of tacos with meat and has an alcohol content of 12%.

22. Toro Loco D.O.P. Utiel-Requena Tempranillo - Spain



Red wine Toro Loco D.O.P. Utiel-Requena Tempranillo is more than a wine is a company for any moment. The red wine is made with the Tempranillo grape and does not mature in barrels to bring the maximum expression of grape and vine into the glass.

Red wine has won tasi awards such as Bronze Medals at the International Wine Competition (2018) and International Wine Awards (2018) and red wine has been praised at the International Wine Competition (2019).

The red wine harmonizes with minced meat with ground banana, pizzas, assorted pancakes, fillet and chips, four cheese lasagna, broth with vegetables and barbecue.

23. Vila Real Winery 2016 - Portugal



Red wine made with Tinta Barroca, Tinta Roriz, Touriga Franca and Touriga Nacional grapes. The red wine has and partial aging stage for a period of 4 months in American and French oak wood.

Red wine has aromas of red fruits and spices that reveal a soft maceration and have preserved the typical aromas of grapes.

The red wine in the mouth is very soft and sweet with balanced acidity and harmonizes with traditional Portuguese cuisine in general and Mediterranean cuisine.

24. Tower Pine Forest 2 Worlds 2012 - Portugal



A red wine made with three different varieties of red grapes and the label is produced in Tagus, one of Portugal's oldest wine producing regions. The wine from the 2012 vintage has evolving aromas and tertiary aromas like leather and adds complexity.

The red wine harmonizes with stuffed chicken, scallops filet mignon with garlic and oil spaghetti, Portuguese stew, ossobuco with parmesan risotto, boiled beef mamma with potatoes and oven-roasted pork loin and the alcohol content is 14%.

25. Quinta dos Roques - Portugal



Red wine composed of Jaen in 40%, Touriga Nacionalem (35%, Alfrocheiro in 15% and Tinta Roriz in 10% and with 10% aging of the wine in oak barrels.

The red wine is fruity and captivating, showing fresh red and black fruits with a fresh profile escorted by floral, earthy, spice and herb aromas that are confirmed in the mouth.

Red wine has a delicious texture, refreshing acidity and a juicy and persistent finish with saline and blackberry flavor and red wine has an alcohol content of 13%.

26. Bodega Argento Shiraz Red - Argentina



The red wine has a dark ruby color with violet tones and has an intense fruity aroma, highlighting blackberries and spice aromas such as black pepper.

The red wine has fruity blackberry soap and a slight vanilla flavor. The red wine is generous, with sweet and soft tannins having an elegant aftertaste and harmonizes with duck ragout spaghetti, manioc gnocchi and medium intensity cheeses.

27. Casillero Del Diablo Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon - Chile



A bright red-red wine with the aroma of ripe cherries, currants and plums, with a slight vanilla aroma. A full-bodied red wine with harmonious velvety tannins, with a slight taste of plums and cherries, generously blended with the smoky touch of American oak.

The red wine is eight months in American oak barrels and has an alcohol content of 13.5%.
